ANNUAL REPORT (2016-17)
Central Academy for State Forest Service,
Dehradun

1. Brief Introduction and objective:

The Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun is one of the three premier forest institutes in the country for imparting training to State Forest Service personnel. The other two Academies are in Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) and Burnihat (Assam). These three Central Academies for State Forest Service are under the administrative control of Directorate of Forest Education, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India.

The Primary mandate of the Academy is:

- a. Imparting Professional Training in practical forestry and related subjects at the induction stage to the newly recruited State Forest Officers.
- b. Conducting workshops and short term refresher courses for the in-service State Forest Service Officers.

2. Activities undertaken during 2016-17:

2.1 Induction Training:-

2.1.1 2015-17 SFS Course-

Professional Induction Training Course Phase – I of 35 newly recruited SFS Officers of 2015-17 batch from States of Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra & Assam who had joined on 2.3.15. As per the DFE's instructions vide letter No. 4-142/Trg.I/DFT-2014/1259-65 dated 14th June 2016 it was proposed to have a rotational training plan. In this regard, it was decided that after completion of OJT, the Officer Trainees of 2015-17 SFS Course of CASFOS, Dehradun will join their training of Phase-II at CASFOS, Burnihat.

Field Training/On Job Training

The Officers Trainees of 2015-17 batch who were trained for phase-I at CASFOS, Dehradun completed Field Training (OJT) w.e.f 22.06.2016 to 21.10.2016 for four months as per the instructions of Director Forest Education, reported at CASFOS, Burnihat on 21.10.2017. Similarly 34 Officer Trainees of 2015-17 SFS Batch who were trained for phase-I at CASFOS, Coimbatore completed On Job Training (OJT) on 09.01.2017 and reported at CASFOS, Dehradun. 11 Officer Trainees from Manipur State also reported for their phase-II training at CASFOS, Dehradun.

Field Exercises:

Field exercises during this phase were as follows:

1. **Ecological Census Techniques Tour** was conducted from 06th to 10th March 2017. This exercise was conducted in Corbett Tiger Reserve under the supervision of Smt. Sarita Kumari, IFS, Lecturer, CASFOS, Dehradun and Shri M.K. Joshi, Associate Lecturer, CASFOS, Dehradun. The exercise was done scientifically using the latest methodologies. The Officer Trainees also submitted the detailed Census report at the end of the exercise which was evaluated by Smt. Sarita Kumari, IFS, Lecturer, CASFOS, Dehradun.

2. **Working Plan Field Exercise** was conducted from 20.03.2017 to 29.03.2017 at Timli Range, Kalsi Division of Uttarakhand Forest Department. The Officer Trainees camped in tents for this duration and conducted surveys in the nearby Sal Forests on foot. The exercise culminated with the writing of working plans by individual Officer Trainee and submission of the same after thorough Viva-Voce on the subject.

Other modules

i. First Aid Module

The OTs also underwent a module on first aid from 10/1/2017 to 16/1/2017 to enable them to deal with emergency medical situations during the course of their career. Experienced resource person from FRI Hospital, Dehradun gave inputs on first aid techniques and dealing with medical emergencies.

ii. Agro-Forestry-Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) Exercise

The OTs underwent two days module on Agro-Forestry-PRA from 28.01.2017 to 29.01.2017. They had hands on training on all aspects of watershed management including PRA exercise. At the end of the exercise the trainees submitted a report on the same.

- iii.** The OTs from Manipur underwent one day module on Forest Accounts & Procedure at Kalsi Forest Division. The resource person for this module was Shri M.K. Joshi, Associate Lecturer, CASFOS, Dehradun.

East India Tour

The trainees from Kerala and Rajasthan undertook the East India tour covering the states of Odisha, West Bengal, Sikkim, Assam and Meghalaya from 04.02.2017 to 26.02.2017. The main themes covered during this tour were management of protected areas, botanical gardens and zoological parks, community based ecotourism and community forestry among other things.

South India Tour

The trainees from Manipur undertook the South India tour covering the states of Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telengana and Andhra Pradesh from 03.02.2017 to 28.02.2017. The main themes covered during this tour were management of protected areas, botanical gardens and zoological parks and coastal zone management among other things.

2.1.2 2016-18 SFS Course-

A new batch of SFS Induction Course comprising of 21 Officers Trainees (OTs) newly recruited from Gujarat, Maharashtra and Nagaland joined the Central Academy and are currently undergoing their training which commenced from 14th March, 2016.

Introductory Tour:

The Officer Trainees being from varied educational backgrounds needed to be first introduced to the concept of forests and necessity to manage forests. Besides, it is also important to develop interest and positive attitude in them towards forestry, natural resource management and wildlife science. Therefore, an Introductory Tour of the OTs was

conducted at Timli Forest Range, Kalsi Soil Conservation Division, Uttarakhand from 4.4.16 to 10.4.16. The OTs camped in tents at Timli and were given introductory exposure to forest ecosystem like definition of trees, regeneration, components of forest, peoples' dependence on forests, interaction with forest fringe villagers etc. Topics like botanization, familiarization with forestry terms and terminology, and broad works of Range Office were also included in the tour. Trekking from Chakrata to Deoban was also organized for understanding of altitudinal zonation of vegetation and also to impress upon the OTs the need for physical fitness in forestry sector. A visit to Asan Barrage to study concept of Ecotourism and Wetland Management was also a part of the Introductory Tour.



North India Tour

As the course progressed, the Officer Trainees were taken for North India Tour from 15.5.2016 to 02.06.2016. The tour covered important places of forestry interest in the States of Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and Union Territory of Chandigarh. Field exposure to various activities like PA Management, nursery techniques, plantation techniques, ecotourism, medicinal plants gardens, Zoo management, extraction of resin from Chir Pine, biodiversity and vegetation study were the major focus of North India Tour. Smt. Meera Iyer, IFS and Dr. Surabhi Rai, IFS were the accompanying Faculty for North India Tour.



Watershed Management Exercise:

As part of Natural Resource Management Course, the Officer Trainees were attached with Watershed Management Directorate (WMD) of Uttarakhand at Indira Colony, Dehradun for undergoing the two weeks module on Land Use and Watershed Management from 18.07.2016 to 02.08.2016. The first week included interactive sessions at WMD Office at Indira Colony along with two one-day exposure visits to a watershed near Thano and another visit to watershed near Vikasnagar. This was followed by detailed PRA and Watershed Micro-planning exercise in three different villages near Satpuli, Pauri District, Uttarakhand. The Officer Trainees were divided into three groups and each group stayed in three different villages namely Unchakot, Salan and Sanglakoti where they interacted with villagers and field officials of Watershed Division, Pauri. The Officer Trainees learnt and practiced different tools of Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA), and integration of various components of watershed management like forestry, Agro-forestry, horticulture and socio-economic development. The Officer trainees prepared microplans for the villages in which they had stayed and carried out the field exercises. The evaluation of their presentations was done jointly by Faculty and the Field Officers of Watershed Division Pauri and Officials of WMD. The whole exercise not only developed PRA and watershed management skills among the trainees but also changed their attitude to become more people friendly and adopt a solution based approach while solving people and natural resource management solutions. Mr. Abhilash D., IFS, Lecturer was in-charge of Watershed Management Exercise.



2.1.3 Extra-curricular activities:

In addition to classroom lectures, practical classes and field visits the OTs also participated in many extracurricular activities.

- *Tree Watch* – an initiative to inculcate nature and tree appreciation was conducted by Dr. Surabhi Rai, IFS, Lecturer CASFOS Dehradun. This activity was aimed to enhance the observation skills of the OTs besides familiarizing them to the morphology and phenology of different tree species in the campus.
- Yoga was incorporated in morning PT schedule for fitness and well being of the OTs. Regular evening Sports and Games were also ensured wherein the Officer Trainees played games like Volley Ball, Badminton and Lawn Tennis.
- Logo making competition was held from 06th to 14th June 2016 as part Swachh Bharat Abhiyan in addition to cleaning the campus by Officers' Club.
- An excursion to Mussoorie was conducted wherein external Resource Persons Dr. M.N. Jha and Dr. A.K. Raina took the OTs for studying geological formations and soil formations in and around Mussoorie on 07.05.2016.
- International Yoga Day was also observed by all the Officer Trainees on 21.06.2016.

- Van Mahotsav was observed on 23.06.2016 in the campus wherein the OTs along with Principal CASFOS, Faculty and Staff planted medicinal plants along the boundary of CASFOS Campus. This not only inculcated the message of planting but also educated the OTs regarding the planted medicinal plants and trees.
- Laying more importance to stress management in daily life, the OTs were given training on Stress Management and Life Skills under the Government Executive Programme of the Art of Living from 05.07.2016 to 09.07.2016 at CASFOS Dehradun.
- A Blood Donation camp was organized on 16.07.2016 in association with Indian Medical Association – Blood Bank, Dehradun wherein all the eligible Officer Trainees donated blood along with Faculty & Staff of CASFOS Dehradun and other volunteers from outside as well.
- Rajbhasha Pakhwada was held in the Academy from September 2, 2016 to September 15, 2016. On this occasion, several competitions like - Hindi typing competition on computer, Essay competition and hand writing competition etc. was organized by the Academy, in which faculty members, trainees and staff members participated.
- Training-cum-demonstration on City Farming for Disposal of Organic Waste was organized by CASFOS, Dehradun on 28th October 2016.
- A Cultural programme on Kathak Dance Performance by Sushree Rani Khanam & other artists was organized by SPIC-MACAY at CASFOS, Dehradun on 23rd November 2016.
- Celebrated International Soil Day on 05th December 2016.
- On the occasion of International Mountain Day a programme was organized by the Officers Club in the Academy on 13th December 2016. Principal, Faculty members, Officer Trainees and staff members participated in the programme.
- One day classroom and practical session was organized on Fire Safety Training & Drill on 01st February 2017.

2.1.4 Visit of Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Environment, Forest and Climate Change

On 02nd December 2016 Late Shri Anil Madhav Dave, Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Environment, Forest and Climate Change visited CASFOS, Dehradun campus and addressed the officers'. He directed the officers to prepare a social outreach scheme called "Samaj Mitra" wherein the frontline staff of Forest Department would contribute in the field of health and education in rural remote areas. Hon'ble minister also interacted with the Officer Trainees of 2016-18 SFS Batch.

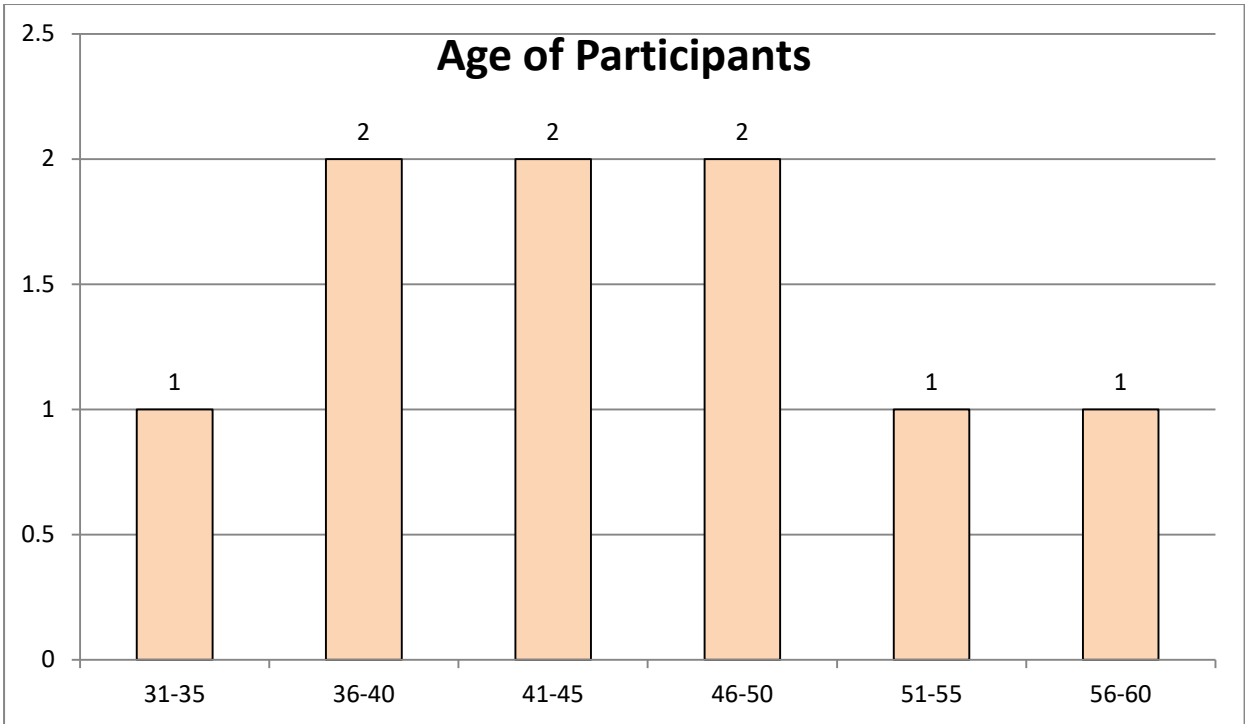
2.2 In-service Training/Theme Based Courses for the financial year of 2016-17
