ANNUAL REPORT (2017-18)

Name of the Academy : **Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun**

Ministry / Division : **Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, New Delhi**

1. About the Academy – Brief Introduction and objective:

The Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun is one of the three premier forest institutes in the country for imparting training to State Forest Service personnel. The other two Academies are in Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) and Burnihat (Assam). These three Central Academies for State Forest Service are under the administrative control of Directorate of Forest Education, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India.

The Primary mandate of the Academy is:

- a. Imparting Professional Training in practical forestry and related subjects at the induction stage to the newly recruited State Forest Service Officers.
- b. Conducting workshops and short term refresher courses for the in-service State Forest Service Officers.



2. Details of Induction Trainings of SFS Officers conducted during 2017-18:-

2.1 2015-17 SFS Course-

The Induction Training of SFS 2015-17 course commenced from 2nd February, 2015 at CASFOS, Dehradun. As per the DFE's instructions vide letter No. 4-142/Trg.I/DFT-2014/1259-65 dated 14th June 2016 it was proposed to have a rotational training plan. In this regard, it was decided that after completion of OJT, the Officer Trainees of 2015-17 SFS Course of CASFOS, Dehradun will join their training of Phase-II at CASFOS, Burnihat.

Similarly, 34 Officer Trainees of 2015-17 SFS Batch from Kerala and Rajasthan who were trained for phase – I at CASFOS, Coimbatore joined CASFOS, Dehradun on 09.01.2017. 11 Officer Trainees from Manipur State who were trained for Phase – I at CASFOS, Dehradun also joined for their phase-II training at CASFOS, Dehradun.

Weapons Training in Indian Military Academy which was carried out from 21st to 26th April 2017.

The Motor Mechanics module was also scheduled on 21st to 26th April 2017 wherein the trainees were exposed to basics of Motor Mechanics and driving.

The Officer Trainees after completion of two year induction course successfully were awarded diplomas at FRI Convocation Hall on 01st May 2017 in a grand ceremony presided over by Shri Trivendra Singh Rawat, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttarakhand.

2.2 2016-18 SFS Course

A new batch of SFS Induction Course comprising of 21 Officers Trainees (OTs) newly recruited from Gujarat, Maharashtra and Nagaland joined the Central Academy. However, one Officer Trainee from Gujarat Ms. Bhabhor Arti Ramsingh could not successfully complete phase-I of the training and therefore, as directed vide DFE's office letter No. 4-163/Trg-I/DFT-2016/2138-39 dated 03.11.2017, she was relieved from the Academy on 03.11.2017 (afternoon).

Field Training/On Job Training

The Officers Trainees of 2016-18 batch from Gujarat State has completed Field Training i.e., On the Job Training (OJT) w.e.f 15.06.2017 to 16.10.2017 and Officer Trainees from Maharashtra and Nagaland State has completed their OJT w.e.f. 14.07.2017 to 16.11.2017 for four months i.e. 16 weeks after completion of phase -I of professional training at Academy spending over sixteen months as per the Entrance and Training Rules (Revised) 2004.

Field Exercises:

Field exercises during this phase were as follows:

Ecological Census Exercise

The trainees undertook the Ecological Census Exercise in the Rajaji National Park from 27.11.2017 to 02.12.2017. The exercise was done scientifically using the latest methodologies. They also submitted the detailed Census report at the end of the exercise.

Working Plan Exercise

The trainees undertook the Working Plan Exercise from 18.12.2017 to 29.12.2017 at Chidiyapur Range, Haridwar. The exercise consisted of rigorous field work with intensive sampling, data analysis and creation of GIS layers by the OTs and writing a detailed Working Plan for Chidiyapur Range, Haridwar. During this exercise, the trainees put to use all the inputs received previously in the course of the SFS induction training.

East India Tour

The trainees undertook the East India tour from 08.01.2018 to 25.01.2018. The main themes covered during this tour were management of protected areas, botanical gardens and zoological parks, community based ecotourism and community forestry among other things.

Weapons Training

The trainees underwent training in the Indian Military Academy, Dehradun from 05.02.2018 to 11.02.2018.

The Officer Trainees after completion of two year induction course successfully were awarded diplomas at FRI Convocation Hall on 12th March, 2018 in a grand ceremony presided over by Shri Siddhanta Das, IFS, Director General of Forests & Special Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

2.3 2017-19 SFS Course

The Induction Training of SFS 2017-19 Course at CASFOS Dehradun commenced from 19th June 2017. Forty Four Officer Trainees (OTs) from Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland, Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh joined the training. One Officer Trainee Ms. Sonu Parmar left the training as she was selected for other service and one Officer Trainee Ms. Priyanka Bamaniya left the training because of medical issues.

Introductory Tour:

The Officer Trainees being from varied educational backgrounds needed to be first introduced to the concept of forests and necessity to manage forests. Besides, it is also important to develop interest and positive attitude in them towards forestry, natural resource management and wildlife science. Therefore, an Introductory Tour of the OTs was conducted at Chunakhan, Ramnagar, Uttarakhand from 24.07.2017 to 29.07.2017. On their return to CASFOS, Dehradun the OTs underwent introductory tour exam and symposiums were conducted on various topics covered during the tour. They also submitted Tour Journals and Herbarium specimens individually to the Course Director.

Watershed Management Exercise

The officer trainees underwent a week long Watershed Management module at Thatyur from 06.11.2017 to 12.11.2017. They had a hands-on training on all aspects of watershed management including field exercises. At the end of the exercise, the trainees gave a presentation and submitted a report on the same.

West India Tour Case Study

The trainees undertook the West India Case Studies tour from 27.11.2017 to 03.12.2017. The main themes covered during this tour were Man-Animal Conflict, Livelihoods, Management of Protected Areas, Zoological Parks, community based ecotourism and community forestry. It was followed by presentations of case studies at CASFOS, Dehradun.

West India tour

The West India Tour was carried out from from 24.12.2017 to 10.01.2018. The main themes covered during this tour were management of protected areas, botanical gardens and zoological parks, community based ecotourism and community forestry among other things.



South India Tour Case Study

The trainees undertook the South India Case Studies tour covering the states of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu from 17.02.2018 to 28.02.2018. The main themes covered during this tour were Man-Animal Conflict, Livelihoods, Management of Protected Areas, Zoological parks, community based ecotourism and community forestry. It was followed by presentations of case studies at CASFOS, Dehradun.

South India Tour

The trainees undertook the South India tour covering the states of Andhra Pradesh, Chennai, Karnataka, Puducherry, and Tamil Nadu from 16.03.2018 to 05.04.2018. The main themes covered during this tour were management of protected areas, botanical gardens and zoological parks and coastal zone management among other things.



2.4 Extra-curricular activities:

In addition to classroom lectures, practical classes and field visits, the OTs also participated in many extracurricular activities which are mentioned below:

- Yoga was incorporated in morning PT schedule for fitness and well being of the OTs. Regular evening Sports and Games were also ensured, wherein the Officer Trainees played games like Volley Ball, Badminton and Lawn Tennis.
- Field Visit to Sri Renuka Ji Forest Division, Himachal Pradesh from 02.05.2017 to 04.05.2017 for the Officer Trainees of 2016-18 Batch.
- A four day module with 127 INF (TA) ECO Garhwal Rifles, Garhi Cantt, Dehradun from 27.06.2017 to 30.06.2017 was conducted for the Officer Trainees of 2016-18 Batch
- Organized a field visit for Officer Trainees of 2016-18 batch to Forest Fire Control Room and Malsi Deer Park, Mussoorie Forest Division on 05.07.2017
- Regular *Shram daan* for cleaning of the CASFOS campus was undertaken on several weekends by the Officer Trainees. The Officer trainees also actively participated in the *Swachh Bharat Abhiyan* programme of CASFOS, Dehradun.
- Range visit for Forest Account & Procedure was conducted on 03.11.2017 at Raipur Range
- Enumeration of Roadside Trees of FRI, Campus from 13.11.2017 to 15.11.2017
- The trainees were also exposed to the rich cultural heritage of the country through SPIC MACAY programmes.

2.5 Visit of High Commissioner of the Republic of Seychelles:

On 23rd June, 2017 His Excellency Philippe Le Gall, Hon'ble High Commissioner of the Republic of Seychelles visited the campus and addressed the Officer Trainees of 2016-18 SFS batch and 2017-19 SFS Batch.

7. Write up of *Swachhta Abhiyan* conducted during 2017-18:-

The Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun has identified and adopted a multipronged strategy to achieve its vision of transforming itself into a carbon neutral campus. Salient features of this strategy are as below:-

i. Reduce plastic and other non-degradable consumables:-

- a) Identification of waste generation sources and segregation into bio-degradable and non-biodegradable at source itself.
- b) Complete ban on the use of plastic disposable cups, plates, glasses, mineral water bottles etc. for trainings and other official programmes.
- c) Switching to hand painted cloth banners instead of banners, boards and standees made of flex.
- d) Switching back to traditional ways of welcoming and honouring dignitaries through coconut and *kbadi* shawl, gifting plants in small hand painted pots and books instead of bouquets wrapped in polythene sheets and metal wires.
- e) Distributing /gifting jute or cloth bags to visiting dignitaries and participants of training programmes.
- f) CASFOS, Dehradun has switched to e-office platform as a step towards a 'less paper' office.

ii. Reuse and recycle of various materials:-

- a) Milk poly bags from officers' mess are regularly shifted to nursery for growing plants.
- b) Old curtains, bed sheets and table cloths have been converted and reused as seat covers, aprons for mess staff and cloth bags for wider distribution.
- c) The paper waste generated in the campus is to be recycled into files and file folders through tie-up with Hast Nirmit Kagaz Udhyog Sahkari Samiti Ltd.

iii. Clean and efficient energy use practices:-

- a) Phasing out of CFL and replacing by LED lighting in phased manner.
- b) Use of parabolic solar cooker in the officers mess to reduce LPG consumption.
- c) Initiated steps for switching to solar energy to meet 100% energy requirement of the academy in the near future.

iv. Managing organic waste:-

- a) Managing organic waste generated in the campus through innovative City Farming technique.
- b) Adopting high speed composting method using patented bio-culture Vermi 3G for utilizing leaf litter and garden waste.

Organic Waste Management through the innovative City Farming method:

The organic waste management strategy of CASFOS, Dehradun is based on the following principles:

- 1) Any waste management strategy begins with identification of the point sources from where waste is generated. Detailed survey in the campus identified four point sources.
- 2) At each point source segregation of waste was carried out into biodegradable and non-biodegradable.

From September 2016 to April 2018, a whopping 6.63 tonnes of organic waste has been managed through City Farming in CASFOS Dehradun through 37 drums installed in the campus. These drums support 481 perennial plants. Each drum is thus a micro-habitat comprising of plants that attract butterflies, bees, insects, birds and other organisms. 644 people has been trained on city farming by this academy.
