## ANNUAL REPORT (2020-21)

Name of the Academy: **Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun**

Ministry / Division: **Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, New Delhi**

### 1. **About the Academy –Brief Introduction and objective:**

The Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun is one of the three premier forest institutes in the country for imparting training to State Forest Service personnel. The other two Academies are in Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) and Burnihat (Assam). These three Central Academies for State Forest Service are under the administrative control of Directorate of Forest Education, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India.

The Primary mandate of the Academy is:

- a. Imparting Professional Training in practical forestry and related subjects at the induction stage to the newly recruited State Forest Service Officers.
- b. Conducting workshops and short term refresher courses for the in-service State Forest Service Officers.



### 2. **Details of Induction Trainings of SFS Officers conducted during 2020-21:-**

#### 2.1 **2018-20 SFS Course**

The Induction Training of SFS 2018-20 Course at CASFOS Dehradun commenced from 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2018. Thirty Six Officer Trainees (OTs) from Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Karnataka, joined the training.

#### **Agro-Forestry Exercise**

The agroforestry exercise was scheduled in April 2020. However, due to lockdown and social distancing norms, the said exercise could not be conducted in the field and therefore the trainees were exposed to the concept of agroforestry through assignments based on their respective OJT Divisions concerning agroforestry models. At the end of the exercise, the trainees submitted a report on the same.

#### **GIZ Module on Human-Wildlife Conflict Mitigation**

A five-day module on Human-Wildlife Conflict mitigation was scheduled in April 2020. However, because of the Covid-19 pandemic and the lockdown, the module was restructured as

a three- days virtual discussion programme wherein subject matter specialists from all over the country, shared their experiences with the Officer Trainees. The interactive module will be very useful to the trainees in the future.

### **Convocation**

Because of prevailing social distancing norms, the first-ever online Convocation of the 2018-20 SFS Batch was organised on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2020. The Chief Guest for the function was Sh. Sanjay Kumar, Director General Forests and Special Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. The other dignitaries who attended the convocation apart from the officers and staff of Director, Forest Education and CASFOS included Director, IGNFA, Director General, FSI, Senior Forest Officers and Scientist from ICFRE, FRI, IGNFA, WII, FSI. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests from various states like from Himachal Pradesh Smt. Savita; PCCF Telangana Smt R Sobha, PCCF Odisha Sh Sandeep Tripathi also attended the online convocation. The parents and relatives of the passing out Officer Trainees were also connected. Total 36 Officer Trainees successfully completed their training and received their diplomas. Out of the 36 passing out trainees, 12 received Honours diploma.

### **2.2 2019-21 SFS Course**

The Induction Training of SFS 2019-21 course commenced from 08<sup>th</sup> July, 2019. Initially, 41 officer trainees (OTs) from Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, joined the training. On 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2019, five Officer Trainees from Mizoram and three Officer Trainees from Himachal Pradesh joined the Indication Course.
