G.S.R. 121.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain Group 'B' posts in the Office of Directorate of Forest Education, Dehradun, State Forest Service College at Coimbatore and Burnihat and Eastern Rangers College, Kurseong, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Directorate of Forest Education and its Constituent Colleges (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1995.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes if, at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Desirable : Master's Degree in physical Education from recognised University or equivalent.

Period of probation, if any.

Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods

Transfer on deputation (including short-term contract/Transfer) Officers of the Central/State Governments/Universities Autonomous or Statutory Organisations/State Forests Institutes/Colleges
(a)(i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or
(ii) with 3 years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 1640-2900/- or equivalent;
(iii) with 8 years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 1400-2300/2600 or equivalent.
(b) Possessing the educational qualification and experience prescribed for direct recruits in column 8.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The

maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation (including short-term contract)/transfer shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).

Only officers of the Central/State Governments/ Union Territories will be eligible for being considered for appointment on Transfer basis.

Note : The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation of a direct recruit shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If, however, these are not approved by the Commission a fresh Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or Member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.
