Course Style

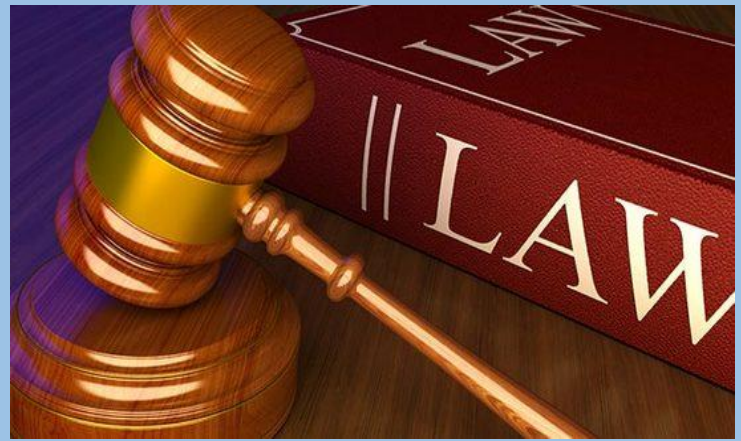
- Three-days training
