निबंधन और शर्तें / TERMS & CONDITION

1. Vehicle:

- a. Supplied vehicle(s) should be registered as Commercial Vehicle by the agency only or taken by third party with proper lease agreement
- b. After the award of the work order, no subletting of the contract will be permitted
- c. Registration of supplied vehicle(s) should be done after 2019
- d. PUC of supplied vehicle(s) should be valid during the entire journey
- e. Supplied vehicle(s) shall undergo mechanical service before their supply/arrival at the Academy or any other pick-up point as mentioned in the tour plan
- f. In case of any fault or mechanical failure to the vehicle during the tour, the agency shall provide an alternate vehicle of the same type on the very same day immediately.
- g. Agency shall provide additional vehicle(s) at the same rates, as and when required during the tour or till the validity of the bid
- h. The AC in all supplied vehicles should be working efficiently and properly
- i. The interior of the supplied vehicles should be neat and clean, and also to be clean on a daily basis
- j. Multi-axle bus of up to 27 and 35 seaters should have enough space to place the luggage of minimum 27 and 35 passengers inside the luggage box/compartments respectively
- k. Multi-axle Bus provided must have pushback seats and hand rest

2. Running Expenditure:

- a. Payment towards P.O.L., toll tax, permit charges, insurance, inter-state tax, inner line permit (in Nagaland or any other North-eastern states), parking charges etc., shall be paid by the agency only for all vehicles
- b. Before/during the tour, expenditure of all types incurred by any of the supplied vehicles like repair, maintenance, tarpaulin, ropes, chains, etc., shall be borne by the agency only
- c. In case of unforeseen circumstances, if any cost or charges of repair, maintenance, parking, etc. is being paid by the passenger, tour in-charge, or academy, same shall be deducted during the final payment

3. Permission:

- a. All local permission required (including inner line permit in Nagaland or any other North-eastern states) for movement of supplied vehicles in the places in respective states as per all 3 tour plans will be taken by the agency only, very well in advance
- b. In case vehicle/transport association of the respective states does not allow/permit to use/move the hired vehicles in their states, then service provider shall provide vehicles hired from the state union/association immediately on their own cost

- c. Academy will not pay additional cost for anything whatsoever including state tax, GST, etc., for above such hiring

4. Mileage:

- a. No kilometer shall be counted to reach the starting or pick up point from the academy or on each day during the tour respectively
- b. Distances & places of visit mentioned in the detailed tour plans of all 3 tours (**Appendix – 10, 11, and 12**) are indicative and tentative
- c. Actual Distance may increase or decrease as per the final place of visit, hence the bid price submitted as per Appendix – 7, 8, and 9 shall include all types of certainty
- d. No payment for extra mileage and hours in a day during the entire tour will be paid by any of the passenger or the Academy to the vendor or driver/staff

5. Driver:

- a. The driver(s) must be given all necessary documents of the supplied vehicle(s) by the agency like Registration of Vehicles (RC), Road Permit, Fitness Certificate, Insurance document, etc., before their arrival at the Academy
- b. The driver and staff of supplied vehicle(s) should be instructed to be in a proper uniform/dress, always maintain decent behavior, not being drunk, and to follow the directions of the Tour-In-Charge, Transport In-charges, Vehicle representative or any other officers assigned
- c. In case any driver is found to be in a drunken state or observed to have consumed alcohol and driving, then the agency will have to replace the concerned driver on the very same day immediately
- d. Before/during the tour, no advance of any kind shall be made to the driver(s) by the Academy. They should therefore be provided with sufficient money to cover all the running expenses of the vehicles by the agency
- e. The Academy shall not be responsible for accommodation, food, and other personal/daily expenses of the drivers and staff provided
- f. The Academy shall have no responsibility whatsoever for the personal problems of the vehicle driver and staff. These will be looked in and settled by the agency only

6. Other Conditions:

- a. The liability for any kind of loss and damage to the luggage of any passenger or third party will be borne by the agency. Agency shall therefore pay the cost of the loss/damage, as decided by the competent authority based on the report of the Tour-In-Charge and/or passenger(s)
- b. Any damage/injury to any party on account of any accident during the currency of this service must be settled and compensated by the agency only. In case of an accident or injury to the driver of a vehicle during the use of supplied vehicle in government use, the responsibility of the damage to vehicle or the driver shall neither be on government nor on the Academy. It will solely be the responsibility of the agency providing vehicles

7. Bid condition:

- a. Bid rates will be valid for a period of 180 days from the date of issue of the work order
- b. Bid security i.e., EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest
- c. To ensure due performance of the contract, Performance Security i.e. 5% of the final bid value in form of FDR/DD/Banker's cheque/ Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank drawn in favor of 'The Principal, Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun' and payable at Dehradun is to be submitted by the successful bidder in 10 days of issue of the work order
- d. Bid security i.e., EMD will be returned to the successful bidder on receipt of the above Performance Security
